



## **First United Methodist Church Worship Plan**

*The following guidelines are for First United Methodist Church decided by the Administrative Council.*

### **Before the Worship Service**

1. If you are not feeling well, please stay home!
2. We will continue the live stream and the radio broadcasts.
3. Use of face masks are optional.
4. We will have hand sanitizer and disposable face masks for people at each entrance into the sanctuary.
5. Since our seating capacity is 275-325 on the main floor and 40 in the east balcony, we will limit our worship to 50%.
6. We recommend no shaking of hands or physical contact.
7. Van services have resumed. Interested drivers, assistants, and riders are to contact the church office.
8. Bulletins (and other materials) will be picked up and not handed out.
9. All bathrooms are single occupancy until further notice. Please knock before entering and lock the outer door when in use.
10. Please refrain from bringing in any coffee or refreshments to the worship service.
11. Greeting and coffee fellowship will resume on January 16, 2022.
12. The nursery will be closed until further notice.

### **During the Worship Service**

1. Every other pew will be taped off and there will be painter's tape every six feet in the open pew to help ensure people of non-family units know where to sit.
2. The offering plate will not be passed, but stationary at each entrance of the sanctuary.
3. Communion will be served in the traditional manner beginning January 2, 2022. Prepackaged commercial packs will remain available for those interested.
